To: Property Owners and Residents near the Greenway between the Beltline and Tree Lane
Re: Project 53W0861 – Public Information Meeting for Proposed Bike Path and Greenway Project

The City of Madison is planning a project in the greenway that runs between the Beltline and Tree Lane, behind the shopping center where Rocky Rococo's is located. The location of the planned project is shown on the back of this letter. The proposed project includes two components: a bike path and greenway improvement work. There will not be special assessments associated with the project. You are invited to attend a Public Information Meeting to discuss the project. Meeting details are as follows:

The proposed bike and multi-use path would extend from the new east end of the bike path constructed during the CTH M/Mineral Point interchange project. The path constructed under this proposed project would begin near the Beltline on-ramp from Mineral Point Road, and extend through the greenway along the back of the mall parking lot and terminate at Tree Lane. The proposed path is not planned to continue to toward the west along the greenway west of Tree Lane at this time. This path would provide an off-street route to connect the neighborhoods north of Mineral Point and east of the Beltline with the vast biking network now available west of the beltline.

The proposed greenway improvement project would consist of regrading the channel within the greenway, and storm sewer work under Tree Lane to provide additional capacity in the existing culvert. The project also would include removing the vast majority of trees in the greenway as they are invasive and nuisance species. The regraded channel would be re-vegetated with native herbaceous species that will provide better stabilization of the greenway and that can be more easily maintained.
